- 1. Review target language, in this example, clothing.
- 2. Project a picture of a person at the front of the class.
- 3. Elicit from Ss what the person is wearing: ask about the colour, size, and type of clothing the person is wearing.
- 4. Then, give Ss a set of cards each with pictures of different people wearing various types of clothing.
- 5. Tell Ss to hold up the correct picture as you describe them.

The woman is wearing a white shirt, black pants, and striped socks.

- 6. Observe Ss' performance as they perform the task; e.g., Can Ss choose the correct picture easily? Do Ss look to others to choose the correct answer?
- 7. After the activity, note which descriptions were most difficult for Ss to comprehend. Incorporate those elements into future lessons.
