The example could be an ongoing part of your class or a topic in a unit on Education. The tool is adaptable to various other listening and speaking tasks.

- 1. At the beginning of each class, assign a S to introduce the class by giving simple instructions such as: *Please open your portfolio (or binder); Please turn off your phone; Please speak English,* etc.
- 2. Use the checklist to assess the performance of one listener in the class, checking to see if the S responds correctly to the instructions. Repeat daily or weekly, assessing different Ss each time.
- 3. Collect the information from the checklist and decide what needs to be covered in the class in more detail.
