➤ Do a scanning race.

  - Post schedules around the room.
  - Student A has a copy of the schedule and question prompts such as:
    - How many... When...*
    - Where... Why...*
  - Student A has to make up a question for each prompt (verbally).
  - Student B runs to scan the schedule on the wall and runs back with the answer.
  - Student A records the question and answer.
  - Switch partners. Student B has to come up with different questions.
