This new website developed by the Centre for Education and Work is a great place to find teaching resources related to workplace culture. It focuses on four main areas:

- Workplace Expectations
- Demonstrating Skills & Abilities
- Finding Supports
- Working Well with Others

The types of resources are varied and include (among others):

Games

Interactive games such as the **Coffee Break** and **Taking Initiative** Games allow students to control characters in a virtual environment to explore workplace culture topics.



Comic Strips

Comic strips tell stories about experiences in the workplace to demonstrate learning points and generate discussion. Some examples include comics about leadership styles and unwritten rules.



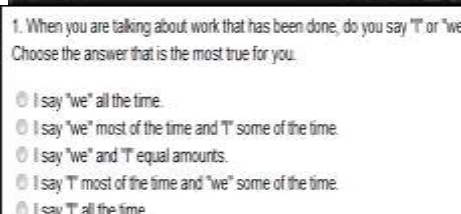
Videos/Listening Exercises
